Now in 2015 this group is still taking care with the help of some younger and able instructors. But if we see that only 122 members have paid their contribution this year and that the numbers are beginning to shrink, then we need a kind of facelift also to reinvigorate our connections.

We still believe that this lifetime karate has a deeper meaning and can still be developed, but we need the support of the membership in their positive thinking and practice through meeting and training together on the Gasshuku’s.

- **Report of the Treasurer**

Alan Armstrong presented the meeting with copies of the certified accounts showing Income and Expenditure together with the current Balance Sheet and talked the meeting through the detail.

The balance has reduced on the previous year due in part to the reduction in membership renewals as referred within the Presidents report and reminded members that a timely renewal is imperative for the future success of the KSKA.

Acceptance of the accounts was proposed by Sandie Hopkins and seconded by Tim Harte. There being no counter proposal the accounts were accepted by the meeting.

- **Auditors Report**

The Treasurer proposed no changes to the current auditors that was accepted by the meeting.

4. Election of Executive Officers

There were no Executive Officers scheduled for re-election this year.

5. Any Other Business

- Shihan Dirk Heene advised the meeting that Sensei Jim Martin is to step down from front line instruction on future Gasshuku's, but wishes to remain in position as a member of the Shihankai and retain the post of Vice President.
- Tim Harte, put forward copy of the Dojo Kun and requested the KSKA consider its adoption as a study of the key principles.

The Shihankai is to consider this aspect whilst taking into consideration factors including copyright.

- Shihan Dirk Heene invited interested countries or groups to consider hosting a future Gasshuku, whilst advising the meeting that an approach has been made by Israel to host the Aki Gasshuku in October 2016.

The meeting was asked if there were any alternative proposals for the October 2016 course and in the absence of any other proposals Israel is to be considered.
The date for the Aki Gasshuku will be 7th to 9th October 2016.

- Gerard Schouten ask the meeting, if there was a minimum number of members required to maintain the KSKA in the present form also proposed the introduction of a junior membership level.
- Shihan Dirk Heene responded that members are responsible for the timely renewal of their membership in order to support the KSKA, whilst the intention of Sensei Kase was to further develop the level of karateka from Sandan and above through the coming together as an Academy.
- Gerard Schouten raised the question of payment for training on Gasshuku's, asking if it was possible for non-members to pay for training on a daily rate. This is to be considered further by members of the Shihankai and Executive, whilst in the meantime and until an agreement is reached, then arrangements are to remain unchanged.
